Whereas, paralegals are encouraged to adhere by NALA, the national paralegal association.

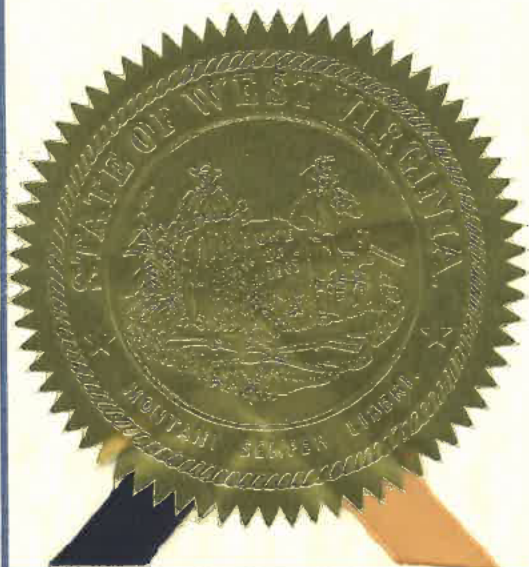
