proclaim *May 11, 2024* as:


## *Cystic Fibrosis Awareness Day*

in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to join me in observance.


**In Witness Whereof,** I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.
