## by Governor Jim Justice

**Whereas,** September 17, 2022, marks the 225th anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

**Whereas,** it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

**Whereas,** annually, September 17-23 is recognized as *Constitution Week*.

**Now, Therefore,** Be it Resolved that I, Jim Justice, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim *September 17-23, 2022* as:

in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to reaffirm the ideals of the Framers of the Constitution by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties, remembering that lost rights may never be regained.
