Whereas, the Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Programs (GEAR UP) initiative is a federally funded grant program designed to increase the number of students who are prepared to enter and succeed in post-secondary education; and

Whereas, September 25<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup>, 2023 has been designated as "National GEAR UP Week" in honor of this valuable effort; and
