**A PROCLAMATION**

By the Governor

**WHEREAS**, a ban on open burning throughout the State was implemented by Proclamation entered on the November 4, 2024 (the “Burn Ban”); and

**WHEREAS**, the West Virginia Division of Forestry has reported that the State has received sufficient rainfall at this point to alleviate the need for the Burn Ban to remain in place;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM JUSTICE**, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of West Virginia, and in view of the foregoing, do hereby **ORDER** that the ban on burning implemented by Proclamation dated November 4, 2024, be **TERMINATED** effective immediately.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.
