A PROCLAMATION

By the Governor

WHEREAS, Calvin Dale Manuel was born on September 16, 1949, in Martinsburg, Berkeley County, West Virginia, the son Ruth Staubs Manuel and the late Calvin Mason Manuel; and

WHEREAS, Dale Manuel graduated from Charles Town High School, Shepherd College, and Shippensburg University; and

WHEREAS, Dale Manuel taught 5th and 6th grade for 32 years at Wright Denny Intermediate School in Charles Town, West Virginia; and

WHEREAS, Delegate Manuel was first elected to the West Virginia House of Delegates in 1988 where he served for 16 years; and

WHEREAS, Delegate Manuel was elected to be the Jefferson County Commissioner in 2004 where he served for 12 years; and

WHEREAS, Delegate Dale Manuel is survived by his mother Ruth Staubs Manuel; his wife, Anne Manuel; two daughters, Sarah Manuel Bonacorda, and Martha Manuel and husband, Sebastain Engel; five grandchildren, Isabella, Emma, Madelyn, Mia, and Charlotte; one brother, Dennis Manuel and wife, Carol; and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of West Virginia, friends, and associates of Delegate Dale Manuel desire to recognize his dedicated public service to the Great State of West Virginia, and to acknowledge his valuable contributions to the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM JUSTICE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Governor of the State of West Virginia, do hereby ORDER that, in commemoration of the distinguished life and service of West Virginia Delegate Calvin Dale Manuel, the United States and West Virginia State flags displayed at the Capitol Complex in Charleston, West Virginia, and at all State facilities throughout Jefferson County, West Virginia, shall be lowered to half-staff from dawn to dusk on February 16, 2024, the day of services celebrating his life.
