- Whereas,** every child in West Virginia deserves love, support, security, and a family to help them fulfill a happy and productive life; and
- Whereas,** there are nearly 6,000 children in West Virginia's foster care system waiting to achieve permanency; and
- Whereas,** by providing a safe and nurturing environment for our children we can ensure they can reach their full potential as the next generation of West Virginia leaders, helping to secure the future of our state; and
- Whereas,** the collaboration of both public and private adoption agencies, including the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources, Mission WV, community agencies, religious organizations, businesses, resource/foster families, and others should be recognized for their commitment to the needs of children in West Virginia; and
- Whereas,** It is the privilege of this great State of West Virginia to publicly recognize and thank all families, individuals, communities, and agencies for their dedication and commitment to the greatest resource of our State, our children.

**Now, Therefore,** Be it Resolved that I, Jim Justice, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim *November 2024* as:


### *Adoption Awareness Month*


**In Witness Whereof,** I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.
