Proclamation by Governor Jim Justice

Whereas, West Virginia's vulnerable adults are valued members of society, and it is a collective responsibility to ensure they live safely and with dignity; and

Whereas, combating abuse of vulnerable adults will help improve the quality of life for all adults in this State, and will allow vulnerable adults to continue to live as independently as possible and contribute to the life and vibrancy of West Virginia; and

Whereas, vulnerable West Virginians may be targeted for abuse, neglect, and financial exploitation, which can occur in families and communities of all social, economic, racial, and ethnic backgrounds; and

Whereas, in this endeavor, the West Virginia Department of Human Resources, Adult Protective Services program works closely with partners, both public and private, at the state and local level to serve vulnerable adults; and

Whereas, the Great State of West Virginia and the Adult Protective Services program of the West Virginia Department of Human Services, Bureau for Social Services, are committed to protecting and providing for the needs of our citizens through prevention assessments, investigation of reports, and arrangement of services; and

Whereas, World Elder Abuse Awareness Day offers all West Virginians the opportunity to remember victims of adult maltreatment and their families, to promote the programs and organizations that serve them, and to participate in community efforts to improve the safety and well-being of all people throughout our great state.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved that I, Jim Justice, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim *June 15, 2024* as:

West Virginia Elder Abuse Awareness Day

in the Mountain State and encourage all citizens to join me in this observance.
