

# Proclamation

## by Governor Jim Justice

**Whereas,** October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024, marks the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Lord Dunmore's War; and

**Whereas,** recognizing the importance of that conflict is vital to the national Semiquincentennial Celebration of the Declaration of Independence; and

**Whereas,** the Virginia Militia, under the command of Colonel Andrew Lewis, traversed these Counties during Lord Dunmore's War; and

**Whereas,** many people from Fayette, Greenbrier, Kanawha, Mason, Putnam, Raleigh, and Summers Counties are direct descendants of the early Americans who fought in both Lord Dunmore's War and the American Revolution.

**Now, Therefore,** Be it Resolved that I, Jim Justice, Governor of the Great State of West Virginia, do hereby proclaim **October 9, 2024** as:


### ***West Virginia's Colonial Trail Day***


**In Witness Whereof,** I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.
