### A PROCLAMATION

By the Governor

**WHEREAS**, on the third day of September, Two Thousand Eighteen, a West Virginia soldier lost his life and was tragically killed in the line of duty in eastern Afghanistan; and

**WHEREAS**, U.S. Army Command Sgt. Maj. Timothy Allen Bolyard served as the squadron command sergeant major assigned to Headquarters Troop, 3<sup>rd</sup> Squadron, 1<sup>st</sup> Security Force Assistance Brigade.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM JUSTICE**, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Governor of the State of West Virginia, do hereby **ORDER** that, in commemoration of the distinguished life and service of U.S. Army Command Sgt. Maj. Timothy Allen Bolyard, that all United States flags and West Virginia State flags displayed at the Capitol Complex in Charleston, West Virginia, and at all State facilities throughout Taylor County, West Virginia, shall be lowered to half-staff from sunrise until sunset on the Nineteenth day of September, Two Thousand Eighteen.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the great seal of the State of West Virginia to be affixed.

**DONE** at the Capitol in the City of Charleston, State of West Virginia, this Eighteenth day of September, in the year of our Lord, Two Thousand Eighteen, and in the One Hundred Fifty-Sixth year of the State.
